

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-49

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE FIRST PARAGRAPH OF SECTION 9.50.050 OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE, AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 2007-36, IN ORDER TO CORRECT A REFERENCE TO “THE DIRECTOR” MAKING DETERMINATIONS CONCERNING THE EXISTENCE OF NUISANCES AND THE ABATEMENT OF THE SAME AND TO SUBSTITUTE THE “ENFORCEMENT OFFICER” AS THE PERSON TO MAKE SUCH DETERMINATIONS AND PURSUE ABATEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2007-36 of the City of Poulsbo, adopted by the Poulsbo City Council on October 3, 2007, added a new Chapter 9.50 to the Poulsbo Municipal Code governing nuisances, and

WHEREAS, the first paragraph of Section 9.50.050 referred to “the director” as the person who would determine the existence of conditions on any property constituting a nuisance and who would provide for the abatement of the same, and

WHEREAS, the reference to “the director” was inadvertent and the first paragraph of Section 9.50.050 should have referred to “the enforcement officer” as that term was defined in Section 9.50.010, and

WHEREAS, the Poulsbo City Council desires to correct the reference so that the enforcement authority under the Code is clear, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Reference Corrected. The first paragraph of Section 9.50.050 of the Poulsbo Municipal Code, as adopted by Ordinance 2007-36, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Each of the following conditions, unless otherwise permitted by law, is declared to constitute a public nuisance, and whenever the enforcement officer determines that any of these conditions exist upon any premises, the enforcement officer may provide for the abatement thereof and monetary penalties may be assessed pursuant to Section 9.50.070 PMC:

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any code section adopted or amended hereby should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any code section adopted or amended hereby.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.


