ORDINANCE NO. 2014-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING PMC 3.36.050(E) IN ORDER TO DECREASE THE TAX RATE ON THE FURNISHING OF WATER OR SEWER SERVICE FROM TEN PERCENT (10%) TO NINE PERCENT (9%), PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-22 of the City of Poulsbo raised the utility tax rate on the furnishing of water and sewer service from eight percent (8%) to ten percent, and provided that the Poulsbo City Council would review the rate during the 2013 budget process, and

WHEREAS, as required by Ordinance 2012-22, the Poulsbo City Council has reviewed the tax rate and has determined to decrease the same from ten percent (10%) to nine percent (9%); and

WHEREAS, in order to make the rate change, PMC 3.36.050(E) must be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Water and Sewer Tax Rate. Poulsbo Municipal Code Subsection 3.36.050(E) is hereby amended to reduce the tax rate on the furnishing of water and sewer service from ten percent (10%) to nine percent (9%) and to read as follows:

- E. Upon every person engaged in the sale, delivery, distribution, or furnishing of water for domestic, farm, and other uses or the provision of sewage or collection and disposal, a tax equal to nine percent of the total gross income derived from the operation of such business within the city. The tax shall also apply to all revenues from the sale, delivery, distribution, or furnishing of water for domestic, farm, and other uses to customers located outside the city when said service is provided by the city.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any code section adopted or amended hereby should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or any code section adopted or amended hereby.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved, provided, that the increased tax rate established by this ordinance shall apply to all water and sewer service for which a bill is generated on or after the effective date of this ordinance.


