AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON
REPEALING CHAPTER 8.14 OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE
AND ORDINANCE 89-27 REGARDING FOOD WASTE DISPOSAL AND
ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 89-27, now codified as Chapter 8.14 of the Poulsbo Municipal Code, was passed by the Poulsbo City Council on August 9, 1989 for the purposes of grinding and disposing of food waste in the sanitary sewer system; and

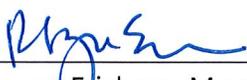
WHEREAS, the practice of disposing of food waste to the sanitary sewer system is no longer appropriate and the Ordinance is no longer current or relevant;

ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Chapter 8.14 Repealed. Poulsbo Municipal Code Chapter 8.14 is hereby repealed.

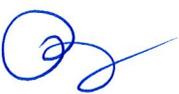
Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.

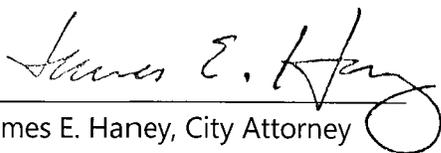
