ORDINANCE NO. 2016-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER, WASTEWATER, AND STORMWATER UTILITIES; AMENDING PMC 3.12.100(A) AND (G) ENTITLED "GENERAL FACILITY FEES" AND MISCELLANEOUS FEES AND CHARGES, AND PMC 13.70.110(B) AND (C) ENTITLED "UTILITY SYSTEM DEFINED" AND "EQUITABLE SHARE," AND PMC 13.70.120 ENTITLED "GENERAL FACILITY FEE CALCULATION"; ADDING PMC 13.90.130 ENTITLED "STORMWATER", PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.12, 13.70 and 13.90 of the Poulsbo Municipal Code establish a schedule of assessments, rates, fees, and charges for utility customers, and

WHEREAS, the City commissioned the Stormwater Comprehensive Plan to be prepared in 2016, and

WHEREAS, the Stormwater Comprehensive Plan proposed implementing a general facility charge to fund stormwater capital improvement projects, and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the Stormwater Comprehensive Plan on April 20, 2014, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on the establishment of the stormwater general facility charge on August 10, 2016, Now, Therefore:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Amend.** PMC 3.12.100(A) and (G) entitled "General Facility Fees" and "Miscellaneous Fees and Charges," PMC 13.70.110(B) and (C) entitled "Utility System Defined" and "Equitable Share," and PMC 13.70.120 entitled "General Facility Fee Calculation", are hereby amended and a new PMC 13.90.130 entitled "Stormwater" is hereby added to read as follows:

Section 3.12.100 Utilities – Schedule of assessments, rates, fees and charges for certain utility services.

A. General Facility Fees.

1. Water. The general facility fee for water shall be as follows:
 - a. Four thousand two hundred ninety-four dollars and sixty-three cents per equivalent residential unit.
2. Wastewater. The general facility fee for wastewater shall be as follows:
 - a. City – Four thousand ten dollars and thirty-one cents per equivalent residential unit.
 - b. Kitsap County – The most current Central Kitsap Newcomer’s Assessment as of the date of connection.
3. Stormwater. The general facility fee for stormwater shall be as follows:
 - a. One thousand one hundred eighty-three dollars per impervious surface unit (ISU).

G. Miscellaneous Fees and Charges.

4. Stormwater Inspection Fees. Stormwater inspection fees shall be seventy-five dollars as part of the building permit fees.

Section 13.70.110 Purpose of general facility fee.

- B. Utility System Defined. The utility system is defined as that infrastructure designed and constructed for the express purpose of providing for delivery of services and shall include, but not be limited to, water supply, treatment, transmission, storage

and distribution facilities, wastewater collection and treatment facilities, and stormwater collection, treatment and detention facilities.

- C. Equitable Share. The general facility fee shall be proportionate to the cost of providing facilities and services to previously unserved property and all changes in use that increase demand on, or discharges into the municipal utility system. The fee shall reflect the equitable share for that connection to the utility's system and shall be computed based on equivalent residential units (ERUs) for water and wastewater and impervious surface units (ISU) for stormwater.

Section 13.70.120 General facility fee calculation

- A. The general facility fee for water and wastewater shall be calculated based on the number of equivalent residential units (ERUs) times an adjustment factor based on the type of service times the general facility fee.

$$\text{General Facility Fee} = (\# \text{ ERUs})(\text{Adjustment Factor})(\text{Assessment})$$

- B. The general facility fee for stormwater shall be calculated by impervious surface unit (ISU) where one ISU is equal to 3,000 square feet of impervious area as defined by Section 13.70.720(B).

Section 13.90.130 Stormwater.

The general facility fee for stormwater shall be as set forth in Section 3.12.100(A).

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.


