A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, REJECTING THE LOW BID AS UNRESPONSIVE ON THE HOSTMARK ROAD PRESERVATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING AWARD TO THE SECOND LOW BIDDER.

WHEREAS, the City of Poulsbo opened bids for the project known as the Hostmark Road Preservation, Project CN2016-07, on August 12, 2016, and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid was nonresponsive due to the bidder's failure to comply with the project's mandatory 13% DBE Goal, and

WHEREAS, the second low bid is responsive and within the project budget, and

WHEREAS, for the above-stated reasons, the City Engineer has recommended that the City Council reject the low bid and award the project to the second low bidder, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES

AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bids Rejected. The bid received from Northwest Asphalt on August 12, 2016 for the Hostmark Road Preservation Project is hereby rejected as unresponsive.

Section 2. Award. The City Engineer is hereby directed to award the project to Lakeside Industries per their responsive bid received on August 12, 2016.
