## EVALUATION CRITERIA

The following criteria are listed in PMC Chapter 19.70. The review authority must consider these criteria when making a decision on the appeal. The appellant's letter of appeal should address these criteria:

- a. Facts demonstrating that the person is adversely affected by the decision.
- b. A concise statement identifying each alleged error of fact, law, or procedure, and the manner in which the decision fails to satisfy the applicable decision criteria.
- c. The specific relief requested.
- d. Any other information reasonably necessary to make a decision on the appeal.

**THE SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 4:30 P.M. ON THE 14TH CALENDAR DAY FOLLOWING THE DATE THE NOTICE OF DECISION WAS ISSUED.**
