ORDINANCE NO. 2008-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, LEVYING THE GENERAL TAXES FOR THE CITY OF POULSBO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2009, ON ALL PROPERTY, BOTH REAL AND PERSONAL, IN SAID CITY WHICH IS SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SUFFICIENT REVENUE TO CARRY ON THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS OF SAID CITY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AS REQUIRED BY LAW, AND APPROVING AN ORDINANCE SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Poulsbo, Washington, has met and considered the City's anticipated financial requirements for the calendar year 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$1,844,433; and,

WHEREAS, the population of the City is less than 10,000; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. An increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2009 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$20,289 which is a percentage increase of approximately 1.1% from said previous year. Pursuant to RCW 84.55.092, this levy amount slightly exceeds the statutory limit factor in order to restore banked levy capacity.

This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of the attached summary which is hereby approved.
