ORDINANCE NO. 2009-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 3.12.100(G) OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT THE COST OF APPEAL FEES FOR ILLICIT DISCHARGE DETECTION AND ELIMINATION VIOLATIONS UNDER CHAPTER 13.18 OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance No. 2009- 03, "Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination", which provides for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Poulsbo through the protection and enhancement of the water quality of watercourses and water bodies through the regulation of non-storm water discharges to the storm drain system to the maximum extent practicable as required by federal and state law and compliance with the requirements of the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2009-03 includes a provision for appealing the "notice and order" for water quality violations and assessments for abatement costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Poulsbo Municipal Code, Section 3.12.100(G) <u>Utilities – Schedule</u> of assessments, rates, fees and charges for certain utility services is hereby amended to add item number nine as follows:

3.12.100(G) Miscellaneous Fees and Charges.

9. Appeal fee. The appeal fee for notice and orders of violation of illicit discharges and assessment of abatement costs of illicit discharges shall be two hundred and fifty dollars. In addition to the appeal fee, the City may require a consultant deposit pursuant to Poulsbo Municipal Code 13.18.150.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect April 1, 2009 which is at least five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.
