ORDINANCE NO. 2010-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 3.12.100(G) OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT THE COST OF APPEAL FEES FOR STORMWATER FACILITY OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE VIOLATIONS UNDER CHAPTER 13.17 OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance No. 2010- 01, "Stormwater Management Ordinance", which provides for the health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of Poulsbo; the protection and enhancement of the water quality of watercourses and water bodies of the City through the regulation of stormwater discharges from new development, redevelopment, and construction site activities in compliance with the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit; AND

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2010-01 includes a provision for appealing the "Notice and Order" for stormwater facility operation and maintenance violations;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Poulsbo Municipal Code, Section 3.12.100(G) <u>Utilities – Schedule of assessments, rates, fees and charges for certain utility services</u> is hereby amended to add item number ten as follows:

3.12.100(G) Miscellaneous Fees and Charges.

10. Appeal fee. The appeal fee for notice and orders of a stormwater facility operations and maintenance violation shall be two hundred and fifty dollars. In addition to the appeal fee, the City may require a consultant deposit pursuant to Section 13.17.150.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect February 3, 2010 which is at least five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.
