ORDINANCE NO. 2016-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 8.20 OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE IN ORDER TO ADD A SECTION WHICH ALLOWS THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS DURING PERIODS OF EXTREME FIRE DANGER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Poulsbo is concerned about the hazard fireworks pose during extreme fire danger; and

WHEREAS, the City of Poulsbo desires to grant the fire chief or the fire chief's designee the ability to ban the discharge of fireworks during times when discharge would pose an unusually dangerous risk to people and property within the City of Poulsbo, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 8.20.275 of the Poulsbo Municipal Code is hereby added and shall read:

During periods of extreme fire danger, as determined by the fire chief or the fire chief's designee, the fire chief or the fire chief's designee may prohibit the discharge of any or all fireworks within the city limits. At a minimum, the Kitsap County Fire Marshal's burn ban, based upon fuel moisture measurements, must be declared and in place prior to this determination.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. Pursuant to RCW 70.77.250(4) this ordinance shall take effect one year after adoption and publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved. If RCW 70.77.250(4) is amended to allow for an earlier effective date, the effective date will be as soon as possible under state law.
