ORDINANCE NO. 2017-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SUBSECTION 15.04.020(A)(4) OF THE POULSBO MUNICIPAL CODE IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THAT ONLY SECTIONS 106.1, 106.2, AND 107.1 OF APPENDIX D TO THE 2015 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE ARE ADOPTED BY THE CITY AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE REMAINDER OF THAT APPENDIX IS NOT ADOPTED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Subsection 15.04.020(A)(4) of the Poulsbo Municipal Code adopts the 2015 International Fire Code by reference, including the entirety of Appendix D providing standards for fire apparatus access roads; and

WHEREAS, some of the standards in Appendix D conflict with the City's adopted street standards; and

WHEREAS, adoption of Appendix D is optional and the Poulsbo City Engineer has recommended that the City revise its adoption of Appendix D to adopt it only in part and to not adopt the remaining sections that are in conflict with the City's adopted street standards; and

WHEREAS, the Poulsbo City Council has considered the recommendation of the Poulsbo City Engineer and has determined to make the necessary changes in the Poulsbo Municipal Code to adopt that recommendation; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Fire Apparatus Access Road Standards.</u> PMC 15.04.020(A)(4) is hereby amended to read as follows:

4. The current edition of the International Fire Code, as published by the ICC, as adopted by the Washington State Building Code Council in Chapter 51-54A WAC including Appendixes B and Sections 106.1, 106.2 and 107.1 of Appendix D; provided, that the amendment made in WAC 51-54A-503 to delete the fire apparatus access road standards contained in the International Fire Code is expressly not adopted and Section 503 of the International Fire Code regarding fire apparatus access roads is hereby expressly adopted by the city.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or its application to any person or situation should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to any other person or situation.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of the attached summary, which is hereby approved.
