A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A YOUTH ATHLETIC FACILITIES (YAF) PROGRAM PROJECT TO THE RECREATION AND CONSERVATION FUNDING BOARD (RCFB) AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.25 RCW.
