A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE 2017-2020 FEDERAL FUNDING CYCLE APPLICATION PROCESS AND AWARD FOR THE NOLL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS – JOHNSON PARKWAY/PHASE I CONSTRUCTION OF THE OVERALL NOLL ROAD CORRIDOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2016, the Poulsbo City Council adopted Resolution No. 2016-04, thereby acknowledging their full support in seeking federal funding through the 2017-2020 Federal Funding Cycle application process; and

WHEREAS, for the 2017-2020 Federal Funding Cycle, the City of Poulsbo Engineering Department submitted a Countywide Funding Application with the Kitsap Regional Coordinating Council and the Puget Sound Regional Council; and

WHEREAS, the Kitsap Regional Coordinating Council has completed the reviews of the applications and has selected to award the City of Poulsbo \$3.42 million in support of the Noll Road Improvements – Johnson Parkway/Phase I Construction Project; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to exercise its constitutional and statutory authority to issue general obligation bonds in an amount considered necessary to complete funding of the Noll Road Improvements – Johnson Parkway/Phase I Construction Project;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council fully supports the 2017-2020 Federal Funding Cycle application process and award of \$3.42 million for the Noll Road Improvements – Johnson Parkway/Phase I Construction Project, with the intent to finance the reminder of the project through the acceptance of other grants, local funds, and the issuance of general obligation bonds as allowed by law.
