## **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-12**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY ORIGINALLY ACQUIRED FOR PROPRIETARY PURPOSES TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SELL SUCH SURPLUS PROPERTY.

**WHEREAS**, the City currently owns certain property that was originally acquired for proprietary purposes and that has been determined by the Public Works Supervisor to be no longer required for providing continued public utility service, and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35.94.040 provides that the City may, by resolution of its legislative body after a public hearing, declare such property surplus and thereafter cause such property to be leased, sold, or conveyed, and

**WHEREAS**, the Poulsbo City Council held a public hearing on such surplus property on June 1, 2016 and, after considering any and all testimony received, determined to enact this resolution declaring the property surplus and authorizing its sale, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Property Declared Surplus. That certain property described on Proprietary Surplus List attached to this resolution, which was originally acquired for proprietary purposes, is no longer required for providing continued public utility service and is hereby declared to be surplus to the City's needs.

Section 2. Authority of Finance Director. The Finance Director of the City of Poulsbo is hereby authorized and directed to sell the property described on Proprietary Surplus List in any commercially reasonable manner of his/her choosing, including without limitation

sealed bid, auction, or private sale, so long as the City receives, in return for each item sold, no

less than fair market value. Every sale made pursuant to this resolution shall be on an "as is"

basis and shall include an express disclaimer by the City of any and all warranties or liability. The

proceeds of each sale shall be applied to the fund from which disbursements were made in

order to originally acquire the property when new.
