RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THAT A LOCAL EMERGENCY EXISTS DUE TO UNUSUAL WEATHER AND HEAVY RAINFALL PERSISTED FROM FEBRUARY 15, 2017 THROUGH FEBRUARY 18, 2017, WHICH HAS RESULTED IN SIGNIFICANT FLOODING AND UNSTABLE SLOPE MOVEMENT IN POULSBO; AND AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS, THE PURCHASE OF SERVICES, MATERIALS, AND EQUIPMENT AND THE AWARDED OF CONTRACTS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO ADDRESS THIS EMERGENCY SITUATION.

WHEREAS, beginning on February 15, 2017 and continuing through February 18, 2017, unusual conditions of consisting of persistent heavy rains have resulted in significant flooding and unstable slope movement in parts of the City of Poulsbo; and

WHEREAS, said flooding and unstable slope movements have caused extensive damage to City of Poulsbo roads and have caused threats to homes, businesses, farm land and other property; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2017, the City Director of Public Works reported to the Office of the Mayor that portions of Front Street, all within the City of Poulsbo, have failed and require immediate repair work in order to address public safety concerns and preserve the essential transportation function of these roads; and

WHEREAS, these unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the City present a real and immediate threat to the proper performance of essential functions and/or have and/or will likely result in material loss or damage to property, bodily injury or loss of life if immediate action is not taken, and

WHEREAS, this constitutes an emergency as defined in the City's Emergency Operations Plan, PMC 2.60.010, RCW 39.04.280(3) and other applicable state and/or federal law, and necessitates the utilization of emergency powers granted pursuant to Poulsbo Municipal Code and applicable state and/or federal law; and

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2017, due to the aforesaid circumstances and conditions, the Mayor of the City of Poulsbo issued a Proclamation of a Local Emergency and reported this to the Chair of the City of Poulsbo City Council; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said Proclamation of Emergency, the City has initiated contracting or repairs pursuant to PMC 2.60.010, RCW 35A.33.081, RCW 38.52.070(2) and RCW 39.04.280 (1)(c) permitting waiver of bidding procedures in cases of emergencies; and

WHEREAS, there is an emergency present which necessitates activation of the City of Poulsbo Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and utilization of emergency powers granted pursuant to RCW Chapter 38.52, Poulsbo Municipal Code, and any other applicable local, state, and or federal law; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That due to the aforesaid circumstances and conditions in and on Poulsbo described in the recitals to this resolution, it is hereby proclaimed that a local emergency exists in the City of Poulsbo.

Section 2. That due to said proclaimed local emergency and in accordance with RCW 35A.33.081, RCW 38.52.070(2) and RCW 39.04.280 (1)(c)), competitive bidding that might otherwise apply regarding the purchase of material, equipment, items and services, and the award of related contracts necessary to address this emergency situation, are hereby waived.

Section 3. That due to said emergency and in accordance with to RCW 35A.33.081, RCW 38.52.070(2) and RCW 39.04.280 (1)(c) the City of Poulsbo shall award, without utilization of a competitive bidding process, contracts and make purchases necessary and appropriate to address this emergency situation.

Section 4. Purchases that have been made and contracts that have already been entered into which address this emergency situation without the utilization of a competitive bidding process are hereby ratified.

Section 5. That the City of Poulsbo may provide appropriate emergency assistance to victims of this emergency situation and take other actions as appropriate.

Section 6. Each City of Poulsbo Department is authorized to exercise the powers vested under this resolution in the light of an extreme emergency situation without regard to time-consuming procedures and formalities otherwise prescribed by law.

Section 7. That no guarantee is implied by the Emergency Resolution of a perfect emergency response system. As City assets and systems may be overwhelmed, the City of Poulsbo can only endeavor to make reasonable efforts to responds based on the situation, information, and resources available at this time.
