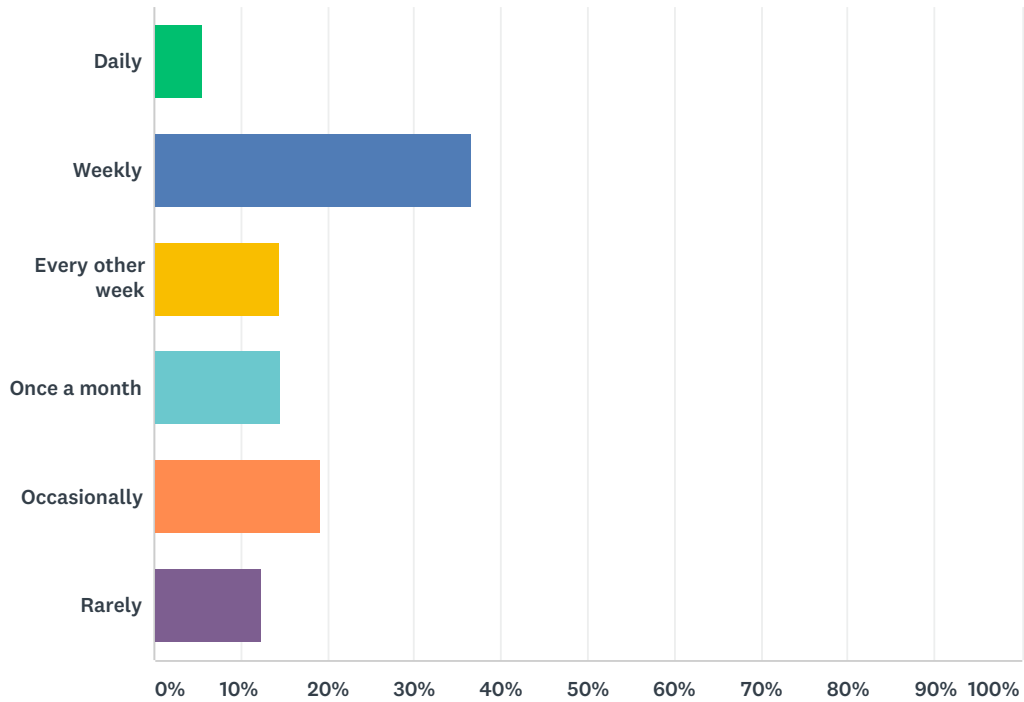


# Q1 How often do you expect you might use the new park that is currently proposed for a central location of Poulsbo?

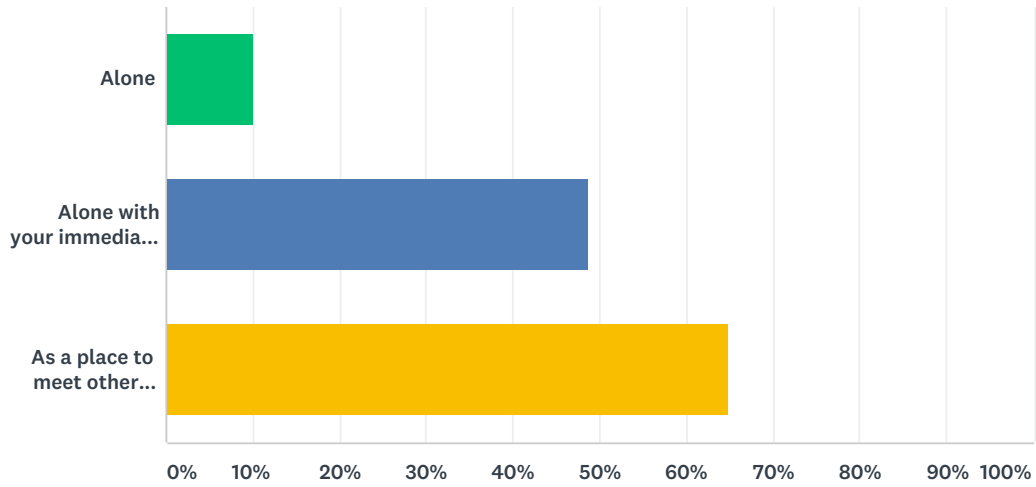

## Q2 In general, do you imagine using a centrally located city park primarily:

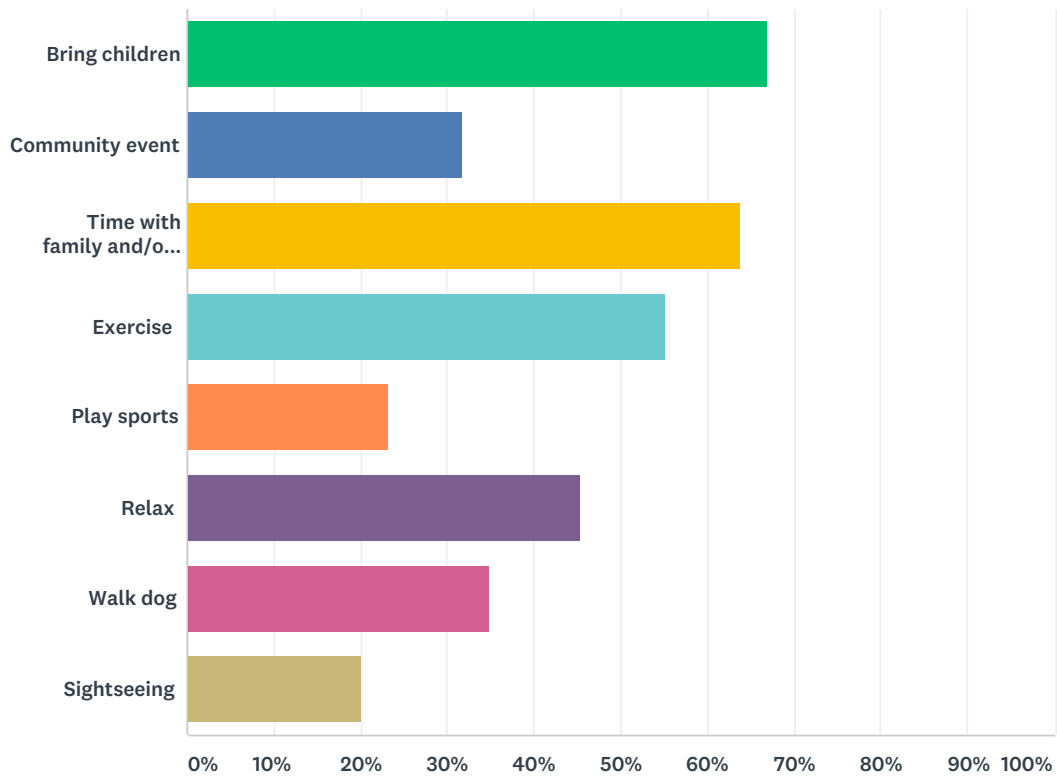

### Q3 What would likely be your primary interest(s) in visiting the park? [select all that apply]

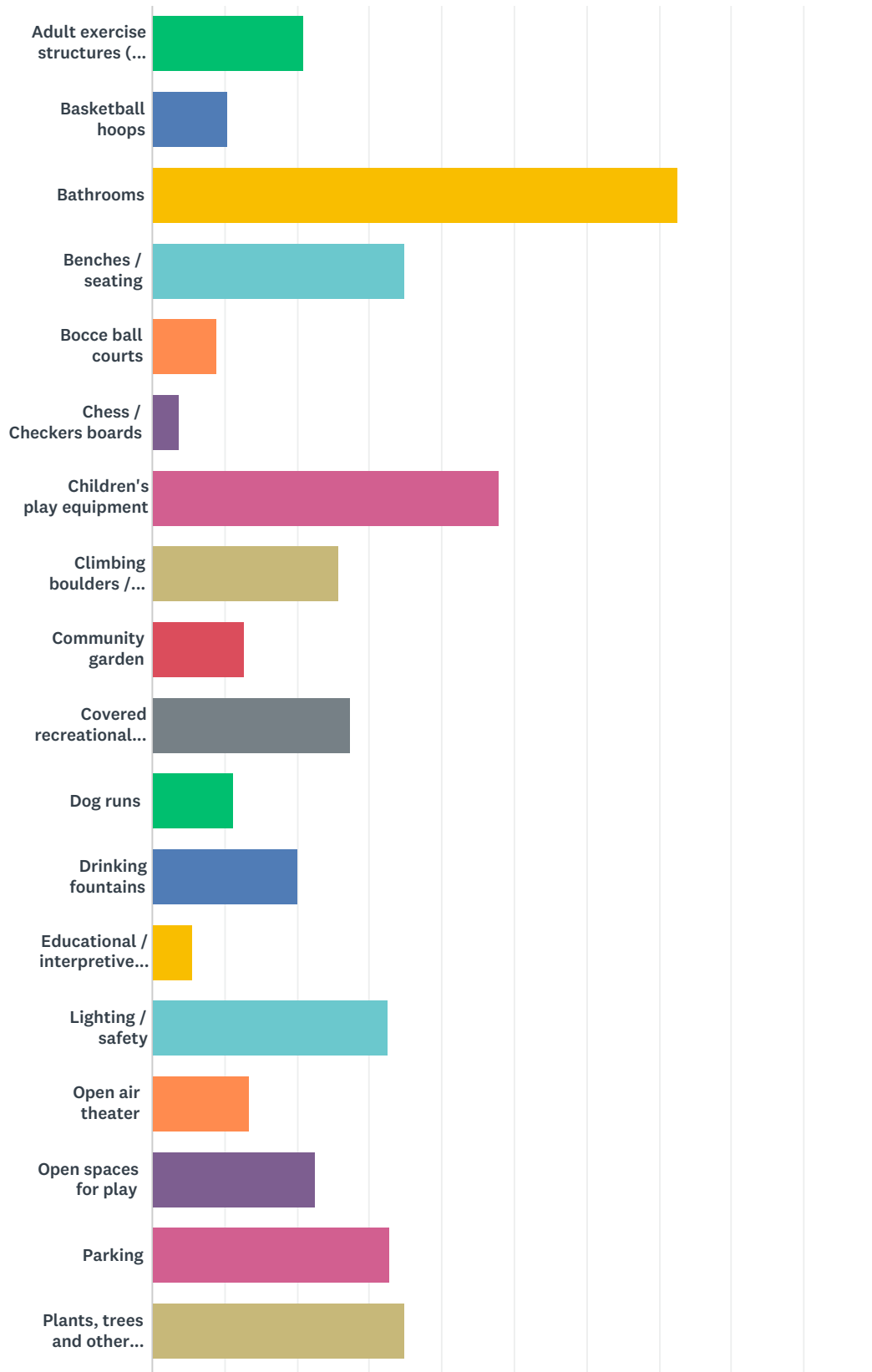

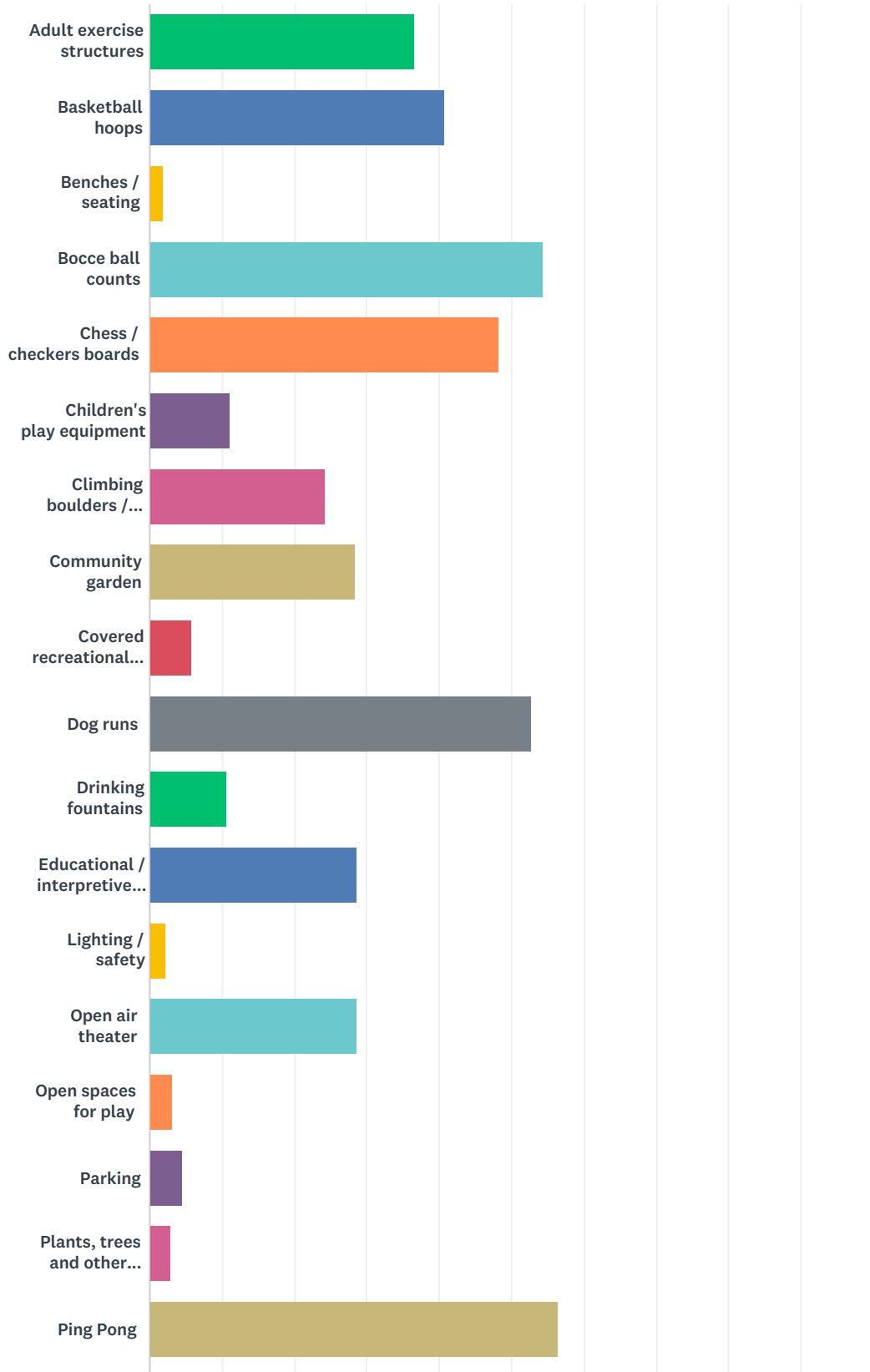

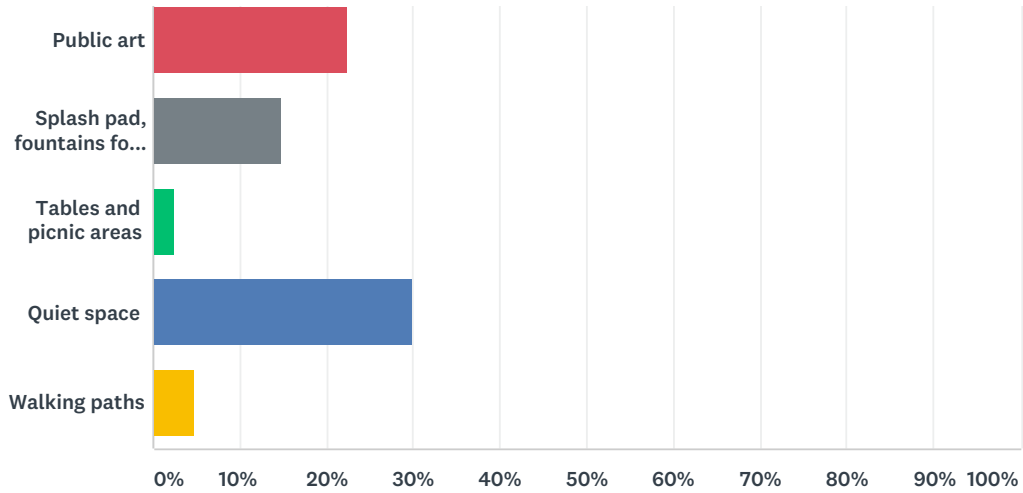

### Q6 If any, what are the ages of children in your household and/or that you care for regularly?

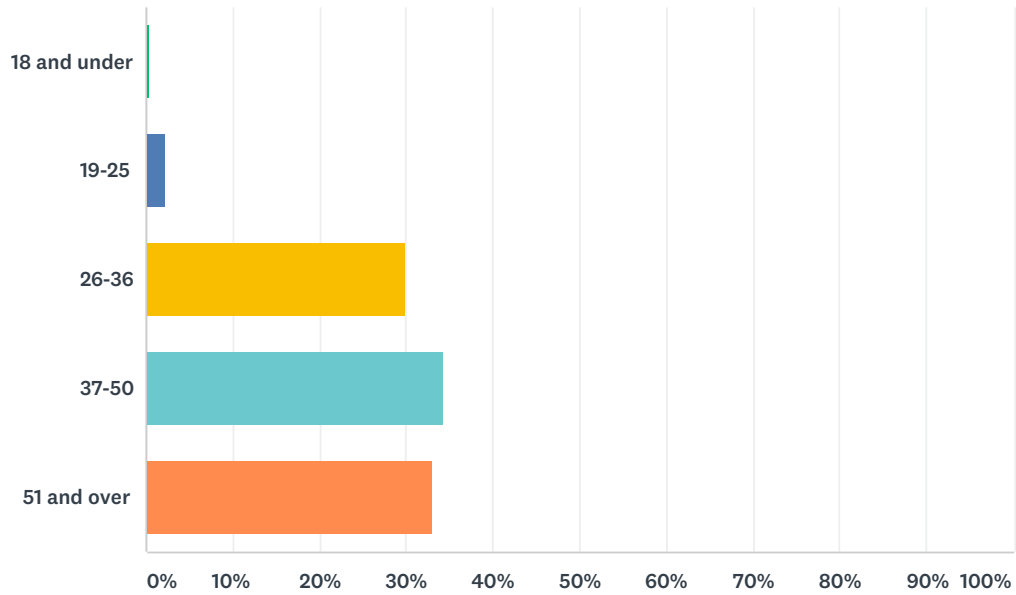

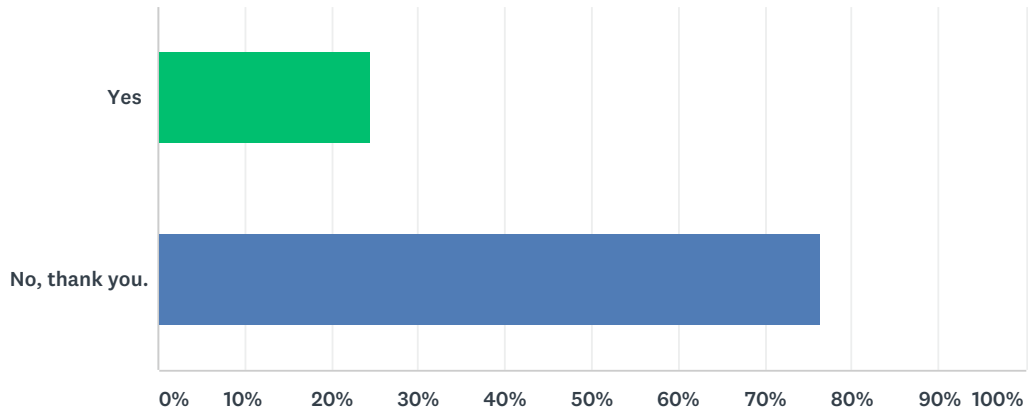

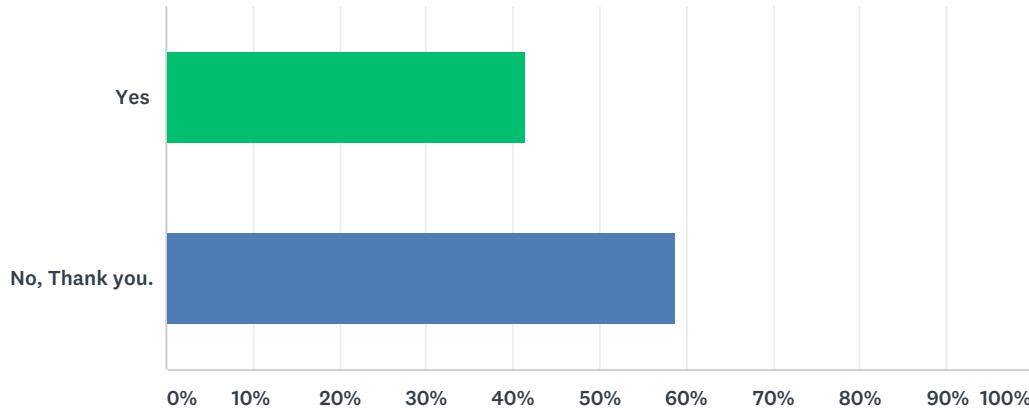

I wrote a letter to Mayor Becky Erickson and each of the City Council members about this park in the spring of 2016. Here are some of my comments from my letter to them. I hope you will consider these options as you consider what to include in Centennial Park: As a side note, we stay in Lynden, WA annually. They have a wonderful long sidewalk trail dedicated to pedestrians and bicycles that travels between different parks and downtown. It is a family fun destination. The town is quaint very much like Poulsbo and has similar characteristics. It is a Dutch community and even has a delicious Dutch bakery. There is a park a couple blocks from town that has two very close, connected yet separate play areas for very young children and then middle aged children. It was put together literally and paid for by donations from townspeople, businesses and community groups like the Lion's Club. The people and groups who participated each have a tile up on walls around the park structures. The tiles fit in nicely as art in the playgrounds. The different play areas of the park are named after the local businesses as in the auto store play area being named with a sign on it. For here it could say, Liberty Bay Auto. This auto store play area has the features of a real store. The businesses are connected like a small town. There is a bank, a grocery store, a restaurant and several other "businesses." It is such a fun park for all ages to go to including adults. We stay for at least a week with our daughter and son-in-law with our young grandchildren doing lots of walking and bicycling between parks, Old Towne Lynden, the surrounding malls of grocery stores and shops and the ice-cream shop. When our own kids were younger we went to a similar place with these same characteristics, Sunriver, OR. They have miles and miles of concrete bike/pedestrian trails between playgrounds and shopping centers even with little bridges over some concrete walking/biking trails as they go under roads. It is a very family fun place. I regularly walk and run throughout all the downtown areas including Centennial Park. I love Poulsbo very much! My daughter regularly walks and runs from our home on 4th Avenue onto Fjord Drive and along Lemolo Shore Drive out to where the old Lemolo store used to be and back putting two of her kids in a double stroller. I have joined her. We end up talking about how peaceful and pretty it is. Very often Lynden and Sunriver come up in our discussions as to what great potential Poulsbo has with such similar characteristics. Her kids love to go to Lions Club park and then to Raab Park periodically. Going to Lions Club park is often a daily event taking the children who are not in school during the winter. They just love all it has to offer. I have wondered if it would be valuable for the City of Poulsbo to research what Lynden has done to see if any of its park's features would work well for Poulsbo. I would like to ask you if you would consider a spray park/splash pad at Centennial Park in Poulsbo. They are quite popular with families as an outdoor water feature that is fun and brings people together. A lifeguard is not needed for these. They can be utilized in the spring, summer and fall. Marysville has one – <http://marysvillewa.gov/657/Spray-Park>. This is part of the description on their page: The spray park is a free and refreshing way for families to enjoy fun in the water on hot summer days, and it offers a great attraction for helping create a sense of community in our downtown. Summer 2017 my family and extended family made at least three trips to the splash pad park in Edmonds. This involved driving to the Kingston ferry, paying for parking, then the ferry, walking through downtown shopping along the way to the park with strollers, kids, towels and extra clothes, then walking back to the ferry again shopping in downtown Edmonds on the way back, taking the ferry back to the other side to return to our car to go home after a very fun day in the sun and water. We would LOVE to spend this time and our monies in Poulsbo. One of these days was a birthday party with 20 people for one of our little ones. A splash pad/water park is useful and fun for all ages: there is an area for babies, toddlers, young kids and older kids. Adults can join in as I did! I thoroughly enjoyed watching a family with a baby, toddler, mom and dad and then grandparents and great-grandparents ALL laughing, enjoying each other while playing in the water. These parks usually have one or more covered areas with a sink and electricity for gatherings, tables around to sit at to eat, relax at or play games on and benches nearby to watch the activities or just to sit or relax and read a book. Centennial Park is a wonderful location to consider for a splash pad/water park when the skate park goes in, the house is demolished, the stream restored and the public works moves. Hopefully, tables, bathrooms and benches can be incorporated into the design. So often we hear, what is there for kids and teens to do that is healthy, that they will look forward to, that will "keep them out of trouble"? What can we provide that will get families out exercising and enjoying each other instead of so much time spent indoors in activities that more isolate, especially in this technological age where kids' faces on gadgets is more the norm even in public? A park like this gives such a wide range of ages a place to go, from toddlers, to teens, to parents and grandparents. People need to eat, to fill their gas tanks, and to buy incidentals they potentially forgot. They enjoy taking a break from the park to stroll the different areas that surround a park like Centennial. An added benefit is all the exercise folks will get. Centennial Park is central to restaurants and shops in several locations including Historic Downtown Poulsbo, 305 Plaza, Poulsbo Village and several other surrounding businesses and fun places to visit including the nearby library. Folks can walk to several of these restaurants and shops bringing dollars into the City of Poulsbo. Adding these features to Centennial Park gives it multi-age and year round appeal.

There was no vision back then and I can tell from this survey there is zero vision right now. Why a single question regarding a skatepark? Check out Port Townsend's skatepark. In the 90's I lobbied for the location and they gave it to us. We built ramps and used the space for years until the money was finally invested in a permanent park which has been a great benefit to the community. Check out Boise, ID. Albertsons donated over \$1million to renovate a skatepark established by a local non-skateboarder in the 90's that hugely benefitted the city. This renovation was completed recently and the result has been incredible. The best skateparks are all built by Grindline which is a wonderful company based out of the northwest who has been building skateparks in dozens of small towns in the Western United States. Do NOT make the mistake of hiring a contractor who does not build skateparks as their primary business. The results can be devastating and can leave you with an investment that is useless to the community (ask Eagle Idaho who have a skatepark that is used by almost no one because it was built by people who did not know what they were doing. The Kingston skatepark is an anomaly, a great little park built by novices. There is a lot wrong with the Silverdale Park. Don't make the same mistake they made. If you want to see a park done right check out the Port Orchard Skatepark... you don't have to be as awesome as that park but the point is that it was built right, by builders who know how to build parks... pay particular attention to the newest additions. Star Idaho is a great example of a small but stellar fun park that you could emulate. It too was built by Grindline. Good luck, and whatever you do, don't screw this up.
