

Reference City of Poulsbo Storm Standards 2008, Section 5.

Content in this section has become inaccurate with recent revisions of the PMC giving direct guidance on Stormwater Design.

Existing page 1:

- "a. The latest edition of the Kitsap County Stormwater Management Design Manual and subsequent revisions; and
- b. The Washington State Department of Ecology (DOE) Stormwater Management Manual for the Puget Sound Basin (1992); and
- c. The latest edition of the City of Poulsbo Construction Standards and Specifications adopted by the City of Poulsbo, and subsequent revisions; and"

The above text is no longer accurate. PMC 12.02.030, 12.02.040, 13.16, and 13.17 are now the ruling documents for City stormwater design.

Existing page 5 item C-7

"For individual lot infiltration in short or long plats the following shall apply:..."

Lot infiltration measures are no longer a one size fits all and cannot remain in the Construction Standards with the current revision cycle of the stormwater design manuals. Specific individual lot infiltration criteria shall be based on the appropriate design manual determined by reference to PMC 12.02.030, 12.02.040, 13.16, and 13.17
