## Upcoming WSDOT Projects

### New Turn Lane

This fall WSDOT will be paving and striping a new right turn lane for Northbound SR3 from SR305. This new turn lane will help separate Northbound SR3 traffic sooner from the SR305 through lanes and help reduce the conflicts that occur as traffic bound for the Southbound SR3 exit merges in the Northbound SR3 traffic before the exit.





## Highway Repaving

Next spring/summer (the date is not set yet) WSDOT will be repaving SR3. This work will include repaving the exits and part of SR305 around the SR3/SR305 interchange. The project will also include accessibility upgrades to ADA facilities within the project boundaries. The paving work will be done at night and will include a shutdown of the SR3/SR305 interchange with a detour around the project when that portion of the highway is repaved.
