Poulsbo Leaders Created a "Dance-tastic" Fundraiser for Early Childhood Education

On October 19th, on a sun-splashed afternoon, key local,









academic, and city officials gathered at Western Washington University's (WWU) SEA Discovery Center (SEA) to award the free public aquarium with a \$6,000 check. Proceeds were generated by the Waterfront Dance, a community-wide celebration sponsored this summer by the Port of Poulsbo, the City of Poulsbo, and the Historic Downtown Poulsbo Association (HDPA). The funds will support WWU's programs for Pre-K through Grade 2 at SEA.

WWU President Sabha Randawa accepted the donation with eloquence. "By combining our resources on the Kitsap and Olympic peninsulas," he enthused, "we impact how children learn, grow and discover, starting a fire in their bellies at an early age."

Held on August 25, 2018, the Waterfront Dance was a resounding success, drawing a crowd of nearly 2,500 to Poulsbo. People came from near and far, by land and sea, to celebrate the kind of event our hometown does best: live music, kids' games and prizes, dancing in the park, family fun, and a super-festive beer garden.

HDPA member and owner of That's a Some Italian, Tom Pelland, stated, 'When we all work together, we can have a spectacular outcome."

"The angels had spoken when we all worked on this joint venture," added Mayor Becky Erickson. "The Waterfront Dance was a lot of fun and it delivered for a great cause."
