DUI DRIVER INVOLVED IN MULTI-CAR CRASH

Officers responded to the area of 18900 Front Street, Poulsbo to investigate a multi-car, injury traffic collision. Upon arrival, officers discovered that the suspect, Berlin, had failed to stop for a stop sign and collided into another vehicle. It is alleged that Berlin then backed up her vehicle at a high rate of speed and collided into a second, unoccupied vehicle. Berlin's vehicle came to a stop off the road in some nearby bushes. Only minor injuries were reported at the scene.

Officers spoke with Berlin at the scene and suspected that she had been driving while impaired. After a field sobriety test, the officers determined Berlin was under the influence of alcohol and arrested her without incident.
