Fireworks Safety Reminders

The following was provided by Poulsbo Fire-Kitsap Fire District #18:

Personal fireworks require personal responsibility. Remember the three B's of fireworks safety:

- 1) Be Prepared have water nearby and put pets indoors;
- 2) Be Safe only adults should light fireworks; and,
- 3) Be Responsible do NOT use fireworks while impaired, clean up fireworks debris, and soak spent firework in a pail of water.

BKAT Volunteer Position Available


