Poulsbo Parks Projects Update -- Summer 2019

At this time of the year, Poulsbo parks are looking good and people are out enjoying the variety of open spaces and activities within the city. Summer is also the right time to do park improvement projects, so here are a few projects that you will see underway during the next couple of months:

American Legion Park: You may have noticed that construction of the veterans' honor plaza along Front Street in American Legion Park is coming along. The excavation for the flagpole base and the base for the central monument has been completed, as has the relocation of the existing boulder and brass plaque to the central base a few feet away. The Poulsbo Lions Club is assisting American Legion Post 245 with the construction, and a professional bricklayer has been hired to lay the engraved bricks. The work should be done by early September. A ribbon cutting ceremony is planned for later that month.

Austurbruin Playground Replacement: The aging climber will be removed and replaced with a Spin Max Orbit and a set of stepping pods in mid-September.

Centennial Park: This urban park will have two benches installed in early September by an Eagle Scout candidate. The donated time and stewardship efforts that have been put into this park over the last two years has been tremendous.

Lions Park: The ever-popular whirl (merry-go-round) will be replaced mid-August. This is the most loved piece of equipment at the park! The tennis courts will be getting new nets and a windscreen as well.
