Census 2020 - Address Canvassing has Begun

The first major field operation of the 2020 Census, Address Canvasing, known as AdCan, began August 4th and ends October 18th. Temporary staff, known as Listers, have been hired to help. Their job is to make sure the 2020 Census address lists are accurate and complete. Listers will canvass about 30% of the county, knocking on every door of communities they are canvassing to conduct quality checks and collect responses for ongoing surveys. Listers can be identified by their badges, bags, and laptops with the "Census 2020" logos on them. - New Merry Go Round at Lions Park (as seen in photo below)
- The new play structure at Austurbruin Park has been installed, but a few more details need to be completed before the park is re-opened. The new play structure is called a Spin Max Orbit, and it's accompanied by custom balance pods and a balance beam. It replaces a structure that was almost 20 years old. Come try it out!
- Muriel Iverson Williams Waterfront Park is upgraded with new sidewalks on the north side of the Austin-Kvelstad Pavilion. Some of the large hedges have also been removed to open up the views to Liberty Bay. Poulsbo Public Works is doing a terrific job on the project.
