
## Short Course on Local Planning



# Liberty Bay Bioretention Project

The City of Poulsbo will be constructing and installing water quality features at three locations within the city:

- School District Campus (Treatment Vault) treats 2.56 acres of Pollution Generating Impervious Surfaces (PGIS)
- Fjord near Poulsbo Yacht Club (Bioretention Swale) treats 0.46 acres of PGIS
- Front Street near Jensen intersection (Treatment Vault)

- treats 0.113 acres of PGIS

Bid open is on February 11th at 10:00 a.m. at City Hall. Construction is expected to begin this spring and wrap up May 2020. The estimated construction cost is \$310,000 -\$370,000.
