2020 Land Use Housekeeping Code Amendments, Type IV Application

Description of Proposed Amendments:	<p>The proposed amendments to the Poulsbo Municipal Code (PMC) are part of the Planning and Economic Development Departments on-going effort to make land use regulations more usable for residents, developers, and City staff by correcting errors, eliminating text ambiguities, codifying internal policies, and reflecting changes in state law. The proposed amendments do not involve significant changes to the code.</p> <p>Amendments are included for the following PMC Chapters: Chapter 15.35, Tree Cutting and Clearing; Chapter 16.20, Critical Areas; Chapter 17.30, Boundary Line Adjustments; Chapter 18.40, Zoning Definitions; Chapter 18.70, Residential Districts; Chapter 18.80, Commercial Districts; Chapter 18.120, Design Review; Chapter 18.130; Landscaping; Chapter 18.140, Off-Street Parking; Chapter 19.20, Application Classification; Chapter 19.30, Application Review Procedures; Chapter 19.50, Public Notices; Chapter 19.70, Decision Appeal Procedures; Chapter 19.80, Time Frames for Review; and Chapter 19.90, Post Decision Procedures.</p> <p>Full project documents can be viewed here: https://cityofpoulsbo.com/development-regulation-amendments/.</p>
