Daylight Savings Time “falls back” on November 1, so it is time to accept that we will have shorter days and longer nights for a while. You can still get out and enjoy Poulsbo’s trails, parks, and miles of sidewalks as you explore the city. Many of us have made extra efforts to get outside because staying inside all of the time is getting - well, a bit old. Just remember to wear your mask and respect social distancing while in public.

Construction on Poulsbo’s Fish Park improvements along Bond Rd are underway. Parking lot renovation, new boardwalks, sidewalk and plantings are all in the plan. The project will be completed in early December.

All City of Poulsbo buildings must remain closed until Kitsap County reaches Phase 3 of the Governor’s Safe Start plan, and it is unknown when that will be. Additionally, the City is experiencing significant revenue shortages. Due to the pandemic and the inability to gather in groups, we are unable to run our normally robust programs and preschool. Four employees were recently laid off, as this department is funded by the revenues of the programs offered. We are trying diligently to find new ways to offer recreational programs. In October we will still run online programs and outdoor classes. While we won’t be producing a full catalog of classes until we can resume full programming, watch for an emailed newsletter that will be sent out at the first of each month. Our community has been strong through these challenging times, and we look forward to new and fun opportunities to serve.

## MORE INFORMATION

### REFUND / CREDIT POLICY

The department may cancel classes that do not meet minimum enrollment and refunds (or credits) will be issued. You may withdraw at any time up to five working days prior to the first day of the class or program. 

### SPANISH FOR BEGINNERS

**THE POULSBO TREE BOARD**

The Poulsbo Tree Board was established in 1997 to advise and educate the Mayor, City Council and citizens on issues pertaining to trees in the city. This includes the promoting of responsible planting of trees on public and private property; promoting public education and proper maintenance of trees; advocating trees within the city; providing for aesthetics within the city through the formulation and implementation of tree programs; developing innovative and joint funding for tree projects from a variety of sources; and providing the Mayor and the City Council with a yearly report regarding Tree Board activities.
