Subject: Sole Source Request for ATEC System

1. In accordance with the City of Poulsbo Purchasing Manual, the City Council is requested to approve an exemption to the competitive bidding requirements as provided in RCW 39.04.280(1).

## 2. Justification:

- a. In accordance with the City's water system plan and existing manganese concentrations which exceed the DOH secondary maximum contaminate level, treatment and filtration systems are required to remove manganese.
- b. The City has one existing well where pyrolusite filtration equipment by ATEC System Associates has been installed. This system functions removes and treats the raw water to a high level with no issues and the City staff are familiar with the operational and maintenance aspects of this system.
- c. The pilot study for Westside Well confirmed that pyrolusite filtration would meet the treatment requirements and the consultant Gray and Osborne, experts in this field, concluded and recommended the ATEC system.
- d. City staff is trained and knowledgeable on ATEC products and technology.
- e. The City utilizes pyrolusite treatment at the current Lincoln Well facilities, which allows for cost effective utilization of spare parts, similar operational requirements, and reduced and more efficient maintenance procedures.
- f. Review of alternative products and brands indicates that additional equipment, larger building footprint and ongoing operational expenses would be required if a different treatment system were selected. This increases the upfront and ongoing operational costs for the City.
- g. ATEC System Associates is the sole source supplier of this type of system.

3. For the above reasons, it is in the best interests of the City to exempt the purchase of the pyrolusite filtration equipment from the competitive bidding requirements.
