FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Budget Amended**. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2020-15, passed by the City

Council on December 16, 2020, is hereby amended by revising the summaries of revenues and

appropriations to read as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this

reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. Duties of Finance Director. The Finance Director is hereby authorized

necessary and appropriate line item entries and adjustments in order to reflect the revisions set

forth on Exhibit A hereto.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5)

days after publication of the attached summary which is hereby approved. This ordinance is

enacted pursuant to the authority of RCW 35A.34.200 and requires the affirmative vote of a

majority plus one (5 votes of the Poulsbo City Council).
