A	Update: Nordic Cottage project, HOME funding application		Discussed (at 17:35) Kim discussed the County HOME grant and reasons the City may not utilize it for the Nordic Cottage project. The grant has a 25% City grant match and 20 year regulatory obligation. Councilmember Lord expressed reservations about binding future councils with long agreements. Councilmember Musgrove talked about the importance of pricing rents to keep the project sustainable and the need for budget numbers before decision can be made.
