## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE CITY COUNCIL'S INTENT TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE ASSUMPTION OF THE RIGHTS, POWERS, FUNCTIONS, AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE POULSBO TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT, AND SETTING THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE FOR SAID PUBLIC HEARING.

**WHEREAS,** the City Council of the City of Poulsbo has adopted Ordinance No. 2021-15, creating the Poulsbo Transportation Benefit District with the same boundaries as the City limits; and

**WHEREAS,** Chapter 36.74 RCW authorizes a city to assume the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of a transportation benefit district created by that city; and

**WHEREAS,** in order to assume the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of a transportation benefit district, the city legislative body must adopt an ordinance or resolution indicating its intent to conduct a hearing concerning such assumption; and

**WHEREAS,** the Poulsbo City Council finds that consideration of assumption of the Poulsbo Transportation Benefit District is in the public interest and has therefore determined to set the date, and place for such hearing; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Hearing on Assumption.** The Poulsbo City Council will hold a public hearing on the proposed assumption of the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of the Poulsbo Transportation Benefit District on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>February 2</u>, <u>2022 at 7:15PM</u> or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. The hearing will be held in the Poulsbo City Council Chambers at Poulsbo City Hall, 200 Moe Street, Poulsbo, Washington. Pursuant to Washington

Governor Jay Inslee's Proclamations 20-28 *et seq.*, the hearing shall be conducted in-person, with remote elements meeting the requirements of said proclamations. All persons interested may appear and be heard in person or may testify remotely. Persons wishing to testify remotely may

contact City Clerk Rhiannon Fernandez for assistance in doing so.

**Section 2. Publication.** This Resolution shall be published twice in the City's official newspaper during the two weeks preceding the scheduled hearing.
