- 7. Joint Public Hearing (With the WA State Department of Ecology) Begins (07:05p.m.): Shoreline Master Program Slideshow (Nikole Coleman)

Shoreline Master Program Slideshow

Senior Planner Coleman re-introduces the project with a brief overview of previous presentations and describes next steps. Coleman lists the purpose of the Shoreline Master Program (SMP) as according to the RCW 90.58.020 and elaborates that a SMP Shoreline Master Program is a planning and regulatory document. Coleman discusses city goals as mentioned in the PMC 16.08 and procedures in 16.09. and mentions other documentation that are not officially part of the Shoreline Master Program but help derive its regulations, these documents being the Characterization report, Cumulative Impact and No Net Loss Report (reviewed by 3rd party consultant) and Restoration Plan (reviewed by 3rd party). Coleman discusses the Next Steps being submittal to Ecology, City Council Review, Hearing and then a final submittal to Ecology. Comments were already received from the WA State Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Suquamish Tribe and private property owner, Jim Rock.

No comments from Commissioners or Citizens.

7. Public Comment Period: None.

8. Close Public Hearing and Open Public Meeting (07:13p.m.):

Discussion Summary: Commissioner Block asks a brief question on the potential erosion of the natural coastline near the boardwalk, wondering if the boardwalk is causing damage or if it is natural erosion. Senior Planner Coleman responds to elaborate that the erosion is most likely natural due to the steepness of the cliffside and adds that the boardwalk was a prior project that was also compliant and approved so it most likely is not the boardwalk.

No further comments or questions from the Commission.

No comment from Ecology (appears her screen was 'frozen'.

9. MOTION: Commissioner Kipps makes the motion to be seconded by Commissioner Taylor. Passed Unanimously.

I move to recommend approval to the Poulsbo City Council the 2021 Shoreline Master Program update as identified as Exhibits B-E; and direct the Planning and Economic Development Director to prepare findings of fact in support of this decision for the Planning Commission Chair's Signature.

10. Closing Discussions: Senior Planner Coleman adds that if Ecology only has minor changes the program will NOT be routed back through the commission but straight to city council, if there are major changes it will be brought back through the commission to city council.

Chair Ray Steven's and Senior Planner Coleman briefly discuss bringing the meeting minutes to approval since it will be a while until the next meeting. The commission agrees to approve via email and suggest any edits, grammatically, via email as well.
