A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, ALLOWING CITY STAFF TO USE THE SEATTLE TIMES AS THE CITY'S OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE TERM AUGUST 1, 2022, THROUGH JULY 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.21.230 requires the city to designate an official newspaper as provided in RCW 65.16 and the bidding laws of the State of Washington require that the official newspaper designation bids be called; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with state law, the bid was called for the City's official newspaper, no bids were received by the City by the packet submission deadline of June 10, 2022, at 11:00a.m.


WHEREAS, the Seattle Times is the City's current official newspaper and had agreed to extend the term,
