Poulsbo, WA – The City of Poulsbo Parks and Recreation Department and Poulsbo’s Fish Park Steering Committee are hosting ***Kitsap Salmon Tours*** on Saturday, November 5th from 10:00am-2:00pm. Come on down to Poulsbo’s Fish Park to watch the salmon returning upstream and learn about the salmon lifecycle. Volunteers will be on hand to talk about the process, there will be a craft for the children, and tours of the Liberty Bay estuary and shoreline to look for the fish.

Other groups expected to attend this event with environmental and educational information include the Orca Network, Kitsap Public Utility District, Kitsap Regional Library, Kitsap Audubon Society, NK/BI Chapter of Trout Unlimited, the Poulsbo Tree Board, Poulsbo Rotary Club, Poulsbo Historical Society, Poulsbo Lions Club, WSU Kitsap Extension Master Gardeners, and WSU Kitsap Extension Salmon Docents.
