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## 2023 LAND USE HOUSEKEEPING CODE AMENDMENTS, TYPE IV

Project Description:	The proposed amendments to the Poulsbo Municipal Code (PMC) are part of the Planning and Economic Development Departments on-going effort to make land use regulations more usable for residents, developers, and City staff by correcting errors, eliminating text ambiguities, codifying internal policies, and reflecting changes in state law. The proposed amendments do not involve significant changes to the code. Amendments are included for the following PMC Chapters: 18.40, Zoning Definitions; 18.70, Residential Districts; 18.80, Commercial Districts; 18.130; Landscaping; 18.140, Off-Street Parking; 18.180, Tree Retention; 18.260, Planned Residential Developments; 18.270, Site Plan Review; 19.40, Application Review Procedures; 19.60, Neighborhood Meetings.				
Review Process:	The Poulsbo Planning Commission reviewed the 2020 Land Use Housekeeping Code Amendments in a public hearing on February 7, 2023, and recommended approval to the City Council. The City Council reviewed the approved amendments at a duly advertised public hearing on March 15, 2023.				
Decision:	The City Council has APPROVED the 2023 Land Use Housekeeping Code Amendments. This decision is represented in Ordinance 2023-04.				
Appeal Authority:	Per RCW 36.70A.290, appeals of development regulations are to be made with the Growth Management Hearings Board by June 13, 2024, per their prescribed requirements and procedures in RCW 36.70A.290.
