		<b>PERC-</b> Dan reported that there is a decent plan in place, and that the steering committee liked the design. However, there has been some sticker shock and some changes may be made. Mari agreed that it is a beautiful plan and wondered if there was any way to divest of any other properties to help defray the cost. Dan said they will be digging into the management plan, which will include what it will cost, how much it will be to manage it, and how to pay for it.
		The City has entered into a letter of intent to purchase the Strickland property, 9.2 acres that borders the west side of the PERC property. It is a non-binding agreement, but the property would be a game-changer and with it, the opportunities change dramatically. Dan added that he has walked the property and ordered an appraisal. He said the property is beautiful, and if it isn't made into a park, will become a subdivision someday. Mrs. Strickland still lives in a house on the property. Dan is hoping to know more in the next 60 days.
		<b>O'Neil &amp; Edwards Properties-</b> The agreements have been signed for the 1.32- acre O'Neil donation property . Dan hopes to have the donation agreement for the Edwards property by the end of the year. The Edwards property is about 9 acres at the corner of Olhava & Finn Hill Road and contains the Johnson Creek headwaters. It could become a nice trail system. Both properties will be great additions that would add quite a bit to the park inventory if they and the Strickland property were all added.
		Mary commented that the Betty Iverson Kiwanis, Klingle and 305 Mitigation properties would make a nice trail system. Steve has walked the 305 Mitigation property and it's very thick with trees and berries. The turnover of the 305 Mitigation property has not gone as easily as hoped and Dan is trying to figure out whose court the ball is in now. He hopes the turnover will be completed in early 2022.
