## PROCLAMATION

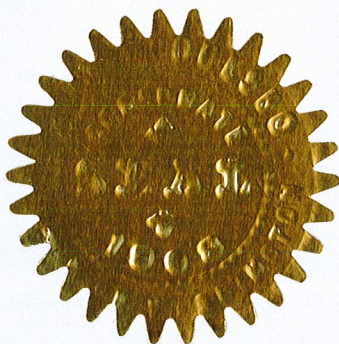
- WHEREAS,** the Civil Rights movement of the 1960's has profoundly impacted the course of American history and continues to shape the direction and debate of our society; and


