

#### 2. Formalize Employee Parking Areas

- 1. Implement HDPA Pilot
- 2. Establish Employee shared parking and/or permit program. Possible locations: First Lutheran Church, Gateway Church, Port Parking spots, City Hall, King Olaf overflow lot, Bank of America

#### 3. Evaluate cost for Parking Enforcement

- 1. Ticket or tow overnight vehicles
- 2. Enforcement for vehicles exceeding the 3-hour parking limit.
- 3. Evaluate cost requirements for 2025 budget request or Budget Amendment
