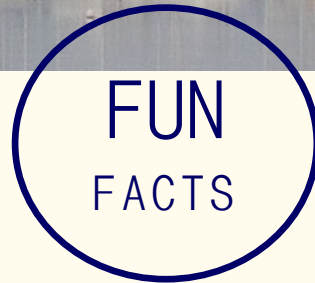

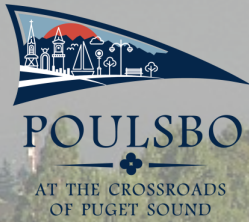

**KPNWT encompasses 371 MILES of shoreline**

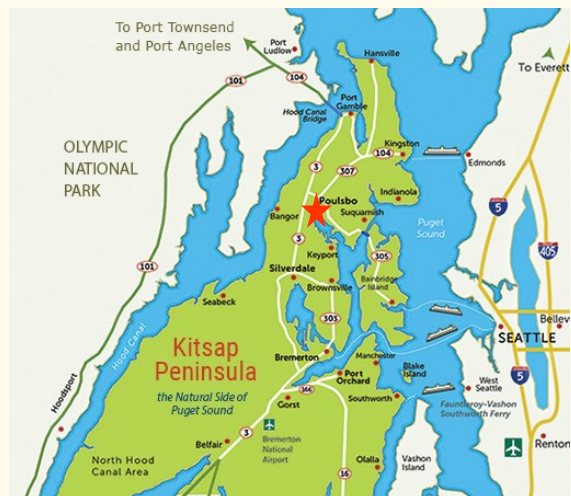
