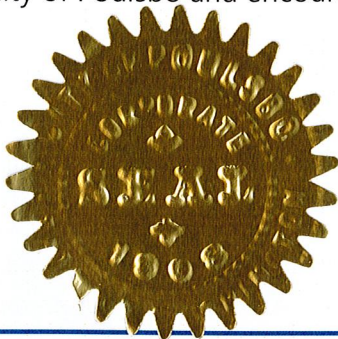
## PROCLAMATION
