## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-13**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE COST SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR THE PROCESSING OF BODY WORN CAMERA VIDEO.

**WHEREAS,** Poulsbo Municipal Code Section 3.12.040(C) authorizes the City Clerk to establish a Cost Schedule for other fees and to revise the schedule by Council resolution from time to time in order to reflect increases or decreases in costs of other fees: and

**WHEREAS**, the Washington Public Records Act, Chapter 42.56 RCW, identifies the City's obligations to provide public records at the request of members of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RCW 42.56.240(14)(f), law enforcement agencies are permitted to charge requestors not exempted under RCW 42.56.240(14)(e) the reasonable costs of redacting videos prior to disclosure; and

**WHEREAS,** in 2014, the Poulsbo Police Department implemented a body worn camera program; and the City is receiving an increasing number of requests for body worn camera video recordings pursuant to the Public Records Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has analyzed the actual staff time incurred redacting body worn video pursuant where redactions are necessary due to an exemption from production under RCW 42.53.240 to determine the "reasonable costs" associated with such redactions; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to amend the City's cost schedule for services provided by the Poulsbo Police Department specific to body worn camera recordings and to set a fee for redacting such recordings; now, therefore;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POULSBO, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Cost Schedule passed in resolution 2024-18 is hereby amended and replaced with the Cost Schedule dated October 8, 2025, attached as Exhibit A hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.
