- WHEREAS,** Black History Month is observed annually in February to honor the rich history, culture, and achievements of Black Americans whose contributions have profoundly shaped our nation, strengthened our communities, and advanced the ongoing pursuit of justice and equality; and
- WHEREAS,** Black History Month traces its origins to 1926, when Dr. Carter G. Woodson established Negro History Week, laying the foundation for a century of Black history commemorations that continue to educate, inspire, and empower; and
- WHEREAS,** the 2026 national theme for Black History Month, **"A Century of Black History Commemorations,"** recognizes 100 years of collective efforts to preserve, celebrate, and elevate Black history, achievements, and lived experiences; and
- WHEREAS,** this centennial milestone invites reflection on the progress achieved, the challenges that remain, and the enduring legacy of Black leadership, resilience, creativity, and advocacy across generations; and
- WHEREAS,** Black Americans have made extraordinary contributions in every sector of society, including education, science, healthcare, business, public service, the arts, and the civil rights movement, often in the face of systemic barriers and injustice; and
- WHEREAS,** we honor the contributions of Black residents who have enriched our community through their leadership, service, and cultural contributions; and
