

Some specifics about the schedule: updated Jan 6, 2026

Get your team number first. The teams are listed at the bottom of each weekly schedule. **BOYS ARE IN BLUE; GIRLS ARE IN RED.** The grade you are competing in is the first of two numbers. This is the number along the top of the column of names for your grade. The second number is the row number your name appears in. A couple of examples from the list:

Miller is Blue11. First number comes from the top line of the column, second number comes from the row number on the left side of the table.
Paraz is Blue22
Jagelski/Cochran is Red23
Brown is Red33
Juhl/Ferguson/Ryan is R11

To more efficiently use the gym spaces we have, I’ve blocked different gyms with their own starting times scales.

Games are scheduled to start each hour. The green-colored blocks all operate off the “Time” column included with the green-colored blocks. The tan time scale is included in the tan-colored block. Example:

There is a 4th grade girls game at 10am at KMS#2, Red42-Red45.

At Vinland, there is a 12:30pm boys game, Blue 23-Blue 26 & at 11:30am, a 3rd grade girls game, Red 33 vs Red 36.

Red54, a girl’s team, plays against Red52 at KMS#1, 10am.

If a team number has an asterid (ex: *84 on the Jan 17 game schedule); this indicates the team has a double header.

Playoffs for 6th grade and above, if possible, will commence Monday, March 2nd. We may or may not have playoff games this day.

Some double headers will be held in different gyms. I’ve tried to have anyone doing a double header in two different gyms have their second game in their home gym. Most double headers will be in a single gym.

When you are copying your games down, check the whole schedule for games. There is a possibility of any team in any division having a double header any date. Remember, **boys in blue, girls in red.** For game start times, the blocks of color all operate by their associated “Time” column.
